City crews will **NOT** pick up items curbside.

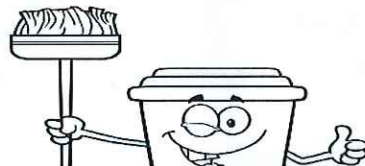
Items that will **NOT** be accepted include:

## Cemetery Cleanup

With the weather starting to get nicer, the Cemetery Crew would like to ask that everyone take a few moments to check out their cemetery decorations and remove any

that are unsightly or damaged. As a reminder, non-permanent decorations are allowed during a funeral, burial, Memorial Day, and the Christmas season. ## Dog Licenses

Any owner of a dog over 6 months of age living in the city must, within 30 days of acquisition, acquire a license for the dog annually on or before May 1st of each year. Owners **must** fill out a form, provide current proof of rabies vaccination, color photo, and the appropriate fee. Fees are \$5 for each spayed/neutered dog, & \$15 for each intact dog. City ordinance states that there is a limit of 2 dogs per residence.
