Summer Compost Hours

Items **NOT** permitted at compost are as follows:

Plastics Construction Debris Residential Trash
Hazardous Waste Tires Propane Tanks Batteries
Only grass clippings, leaves, garden waste and tree branches are permitted at the compost dump area.

The compost area is provided for free to city residents and licensed by the State of Nebraska. If non-permitted items are found during a State Inspection, the city would be fined and would have to resort to charging residents to have access to this area. Please help us to continue to provide this service for free by doing your part as a citizen of the Sutton community.

ATV License

Reminder:



ATV Licenses are due and cost \$10 each. They can be renewed during regular business hours at City Hall.

Dog Licenses

Dog Licenses are due May 1st of each year. Owners must fill out a form, provide current proof of rabies vaccination, current or updated color photo and the appropriate fee. Fees are \$5 for spayed/neutered dog & \$15 for each intact dog. City Ordinance states a limit of 2 dogs per residence.

MOWING REGULATIONS

Section 91-24 of the City of Sutton Municipal Code states that the owner or occupant of any lot or piece of ground within the City shall keep it and its adjoining right of way free of any growth of 12" or more in height of weeds, grass or vegetation. Any owner or occupant failing to comply will receive a letter from the City informing you that you are in violation and will have 5 days to comply. If you don't bring the property into compliance within that time frame, the City of Sutton will mow the property and you will be charged \$100 plus an additional \$100 per hour for the first mowing, \$150 for the second mowing and \$200 for the third mowing. It is prohibited to blow grass in the streets when mowing. Grass clippings, yard waste, leaves and garden waste are not allowed in your trash toter. If you need to dispose of these items, they may be taken to the compost pile located on West Hickory.

Sutton Recycling

The recycling trailers are located behind George's 66 fueling station. The items collected in these trailer's are as follows:

- There are only 2 plastic containers that are allowed. They will have a symbol located on or near the bottom. These symbols  &  are the ones to watch for. Please rinse out before recycling.
- Tin or aluminum cans—please rinse out
- Cardboard—please break cardboard down into flat pieces
- Bagged or bundled Newspapers will be picked up at the curbs the 1st Saturday of the each month. Please don't leave lose papers outside.

Absolutely **NO** foil, glass, tires, pallets, construction debris, wood or trash are to be put in these trailers. Contact Don Russell with questions 402-773-4596. **Please help the City keep this service by complying with these guidelines.**
