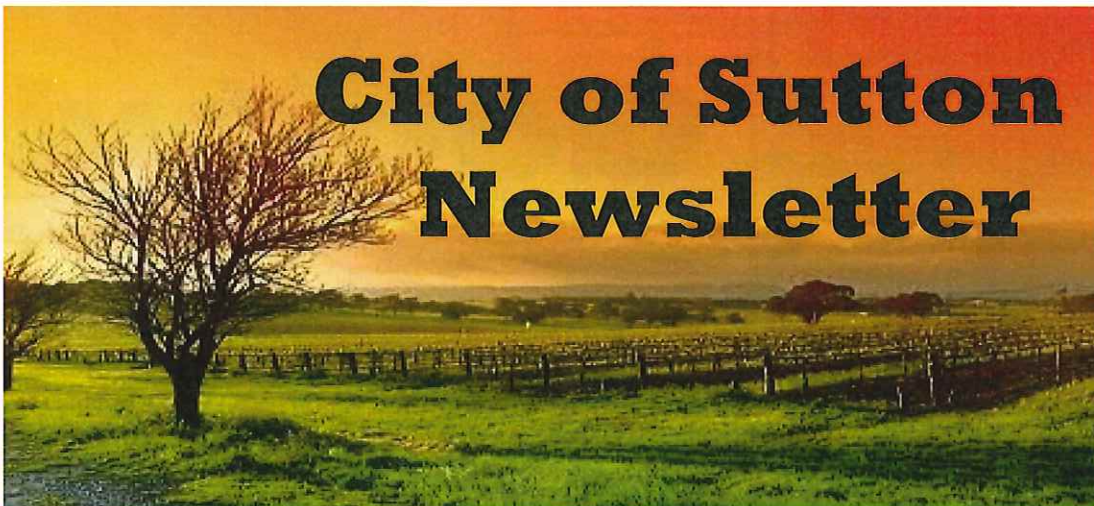

As summer starts winding down and everyone starts prepping for fall, one huge aspect of community improvements is keeping your property clean. It is the responsibility of all property owners and renters to keep their property free from nuisances by mowing grass, collecting leaves and trimming weeds. Letting grass and weeds grow until they are unkept, leaving refuse lying around, dead trees and tree limbs, unused appliances or furnishing, construction material waste, improperly stored firewood, among other nuisance offenses not only attracts rodents, wild animals or insects to infest a property location, but are also in violation of local ordinances. Lack of proper maintenance of building structures (home or otherwise) on a property can lead to nuisance issues,
