Renewal Time!

December is when we start looking towards the new year, but it also means it is time to renew ATV licenses and Walking Keys. Licenses are required for anyone operating a ATV on city streets. In order to be issued an ATV, you must be at least 21 years of age, possess a valid drivers license, maintain liability insurance, have working headlights and taillights, have an OEM muffler, and have a flag. ATVs may only be operated on city streets between sunrise and sunset, and may not exceed 30 miles per hour. ATV licenses are \$10 for the year.

Walking keys grant the user the option to use the Community Center for exercise out of the elements. Annual costs are \$25 per year for patrons 60 years of age or older, and \$50 for everyone else. Adults **MUST** be present with anyone under 19 years of age. Paying renters have priority of Community Center usage. Walking keys **DO NOT** allow the user to hold events or reserve times without first reserving the times with City Hall.

Snow Removal

It is a fact of life that living in Nebraska means dealing with snow. Just a friendly reminder that citizens are required to have sidewalks in residential areas cleared of snow within 24 hours of the storm cessation. We do ask that residents living within areas that students use to walk to school or bus stops clear their sidewalks of snow as soon as possible to keep students from walking on the streets. Sidewalks in the business district should be cleared within 5 hours of cessation of the storm, or before 5:30 am in case of an overnight storm.

Weather Emergencies

In case of a lengthy weather emergency, residents with medically necessary equipment such as oxygen tanks and pumps, or other lifesaving equipment, are reminded to make plans for what to do in case of an emergency.
