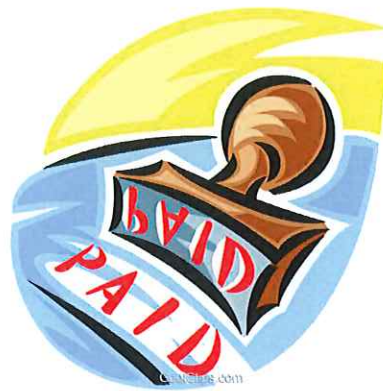

Autopay for Utilities

Make remembering to pay your City utility bills simple, sign up for Autopay today! When you sign up for autopay you authorize the City to automatically take your monthly utility bill from your bank account. No more having to write checks, pay for postage, or remember to drop your payment off before the due date. Payments can be deducted from your account on either the 12th or the 25th of the month. You will still receive a monthly statement with the amount to be debited clearly listed. Autopay is a FREE and convenient option for paying your utility bill.



Foot Clinic

The Clay County Health Department sponsors a Foot Clinic in Sutton the 4th Thursday of each month at the Sutton Community Senior Center. There is no foot clinic held in December. The clinic is open to all seniors and is operated on a first come, first served basis. There is a \$10 fee to help cover the cost of supplies.

During the clinic the feet are soaked in warm water for 5 to 10 minutes, an assessment is done, the nails are trimmed and filed, and lotion is applied to the feet. For those who can't make it to the clinic in Sutton, foot care is provided in Clay Center on an appointment basis. 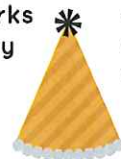
