## Can Care-A-Van

Monday, June 4th will once again see the annual Can Care-A-Van here in Sutton. The drive will be held on the west side of the Sutton Community Senior Center from 9 am until 3 pm. The goal for this year is 5,000 pounds of food. The Can Care-A-Van is an annual food drive which takes place in communities across Nebraska. It began in 1988, when Nebraska Food Pantry Network Coordinator Joanne Komenda and former KOLN/KGIN General Manager Frank Jonas worked together for Farm Aid. The partnership worked so well, it became an annual event. Since then, the Can Care-a-Van has collected over 4,000,000 lbs. of food for families in need all across Nebraska. As with the other communities that host the Can Care-A-Van, all of the food collected in Sutton STAYS in Sutton to help out our local Bread Box Food Pantry. Some of the most needed items include:

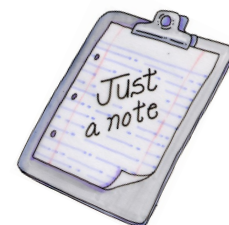
