**Cemetery Regulation Reminders**

Non-permanent decorations are allowed during a funeral, burial, Memorial Day and the Christmas Season. They are not allowed throughout the year. Examples are: Decorative Rocks (with sayings), Figurines, Plaques (with writing or pictures, w/o stands), Shepherd hooks (plus any item hanging from them and Solar Lights. Any flowers and non-permanent decorations WILL need to be removed by **June 10th** or they will be picked up by the city staff for regular cemetery mowing and grounds keeping.

When flowers, wreaths, emblems or other items become unsightly or inappropriate, they will be removed by the cemetery staff. The City assumes no responsibility for the protection or maintenance of items removed. The City reserves the right to remove any and all unsightly or inappropriate objects from cemetery lots. Planting flowers is not allowed on or around the graves.

Examples of unsightly or inappropriate decorations are as follows:

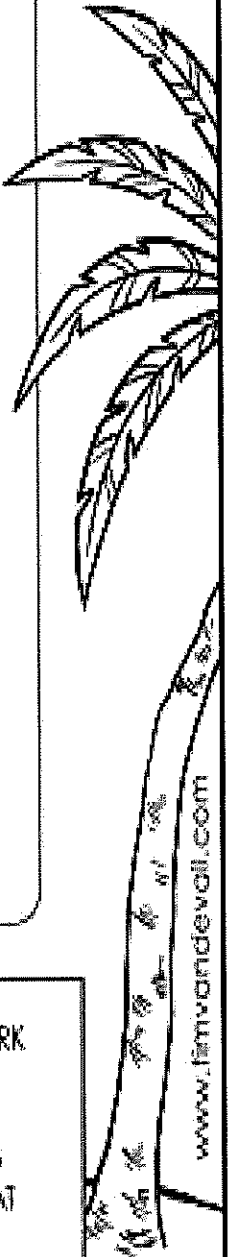
