The Bread Box is a non-profit organization open every Saturday 9-10 a.m. at 311 N. Way. About a year ago they went from giving out a pre-filled box to letting the people shop their food shelves, giving them the chance to pick out what their family needs and will use. The Bread Box keeps laundry soap, cleaning supplies, and personal hygiene products on hand. There is a Back Pack Program with 25 SPS students currently receiving food packages each week during the school year. Volunteers are always needed. It takes all of us working together so all may be fed. The Bread Box can always use paper products: toilet paper, tissues, paper towels etc. if you are interested in donating. Library

Sutton Memorial library is located in downtown Sutton and carries 15,383 books, 164 audio books, 890 DVDs and VHS, magazines and two newspapers; The Clay County News and The Hastings Tribune. It has a shared collection of 22,659 e-books and 11,290 audiobooks which can be downloaded with a library card. Getting a library card is easy, you just fill out a simple form. There is no cost for patrons who live in Sutton; \$8.00 per year if you live outside of Sutton. A yearly subscription for DVDs is \$15.00 per year. The library has six computers with headphones and printing capabilities; a fax machine; the capability to scan documents to attach to emails; & copying services black and white (.10/sheet), or color (.25/sheet). A book fair is hosted every Christmas and in the summer they offer a reading program for K-6. A new program will be starting soon that includes a mom's coffee/preschool activity once a week. The library will also be holding some informational meetings about starting businesses and USDA loans on housing. Starting September 2017 through October 2017 a Jr/Sr high school tutoring program is in the works. For more info call 402-773-5259.
