Online Utility Payment

Visit the City of Sutton Website to view and/or pay your bill online. To pay your bill online, go to Bill Payment and enter your information. To sign up and view your bill, click on **View E-Bills**. Click on **Learn How to Register** for step by step instructions in how to register your account. This portal will only be used to view your bill not pay it. You will continue to use Bill Payment for payment of your bill with a credit card. Once your account is registered, you can add account(s) that you would like to view for the following month. With your paper bill in hand, enter the appropriate information. The account number must have the hyphen in order to recognize your account shown in the upper left corner. In order to view your June bill, your account(s) must be registered and entered by May 25th. Your account can also be set up on autopay so you never have to worry about timely payment of your bill. The Six Rules to Keep Nebraska Healthy are as follows:

- 1 - **Stay Home**. No non-essential errands and no social gatherings. Respect the ten-person limit.
- 2 - Socially distance your **work**. Work from home or use the six-foot rule as much as possible in the workplace.
- 3 - **Shop alone** and only shop once a week. Do not take family with you.
- 4 - Help **kids** follow social distancing. Play at home. No groups sports and no play grounds.
- 5 - Help **senior citizens** stay at home by shopping for them. Do not visit long-term care facilities.
- 6 - **Exercise** daily at home or with an appropriately socially-distanced activity.

ATV License

ATV Licenses are due and cost \$10 each. They can be renewed during regular business hours at City Hall.

Dog Licenses

Dog Licenses are due May 1st of each year. Owners must fill out a



form, provide current proof of rabies vaccination, current or updated color photo and the appropriate fee. Fees are \$5 for spayed/neutered dog & \$15 for each intact dog. City Ordinance states a limit of 2 dogs per residence.
