A New Playground Area for Sutton City Park.

By the end of June 2017, the Sutton's city park located at Saunders & Ash Street will hopefully have a new playground area to complement its many existing features. Discussions for this new development in the park started in the spring of 2016 with the Park Board as the Vision Implementation Plan (VIP) was being completed. Considering community input from residents, the VIP pointed toward more improvements toward recreation/parks. The plan is to have the new play area with equipment surrounded with safety surfacing, pour-in-place material. A visual graphic of the new play area is shown below:
