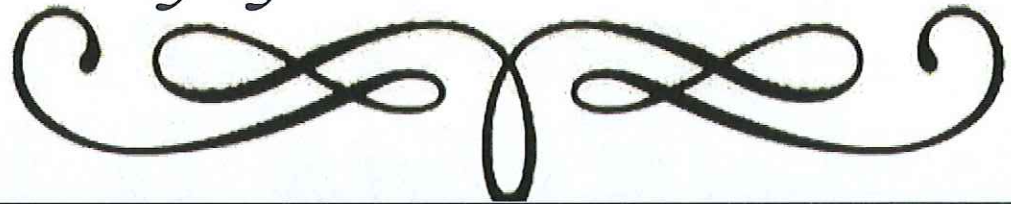

Firework Safety

With the skies soon becoming filled with the snaps and pops of fireworks, we feel it is a good time to remind

- everyone of some simple firework safety tips:
- ◆ Always light fireworks in areas that are clear of combustible materials. Never light fireworks indoors, or shoot fireworks from glass or metal containers.
- ◆ Don't lean over fireworks to light them and only light one at a time. After the firework is lit, get away quickly.
- ◆ Never try to relight a 'dud'. Wait for 10 minutes, then soak the 'dud' with water.
- ◆ Always keep a bucket of water and a water hose close by in case of fire or mishap.
- ◆ Never let small children light fireworks or be close to where fireworks are being shot off.
- ◆ Never aim fireworks at people, animals, or structures.
- ◆ After a firework is spent, wait a few minutes then soak the fireworks with water. Dispose of in a metal container away from any combustible materials.

When it comes to fireworks always use common sense. Have fun, but please remember to be respectful of your neighbors and other 4th of July revelers.

Total Solar Eclipse

August 21 will bring a chance to witness the total solar eclipse from a viewpoint that is almost in the direct center of the eclipse path. People in Sutton will experience a totality duration of 2 minutes and 30 seconds starting around 12:59 PM. The Sutton Area Chamber of Commerce will be hosting a community viewing event at the High School football field. The National Space Science and Technology Institute will also be bringing their MESO project to share with the school students during the eclipse. If you will be viewing the eclipse, please remember that eye safety is of the utmost importance! Any time any part of the sun is still visible, you must view it through certified solar viewing lenses. The Chamber of Commerce will be handing out a limited number of viewing lenses on a first come, first served basis on that day. Solar viewing glasses can be purchased online, but please be sure that you are buying from a reputable source offering certified viewing glasses. Again, any time ANY part of the sun is visible it needs to be viewed through solar viewing lenses or there is a risk of permanent eye damage.
