## SNOW REMOVAL

It is a fact of life that living in Nebraska means dealing with snow. Just a friendly reminder that citizens are required to have sidewalks in residential areas cleared of snow within 24 hours of the snow cessation. We do ask that residents living within areas that students use to walk to school or bus stops clear their sidewalks of snow as soon as possible to keep students from walking on the streets. Sidewalks in the business district should be cleared within 5 hours of cessation of the storm, or before 5:30 am to allow the city staff to properly keep the downtown parking areas and streets cleared in a timely manner.

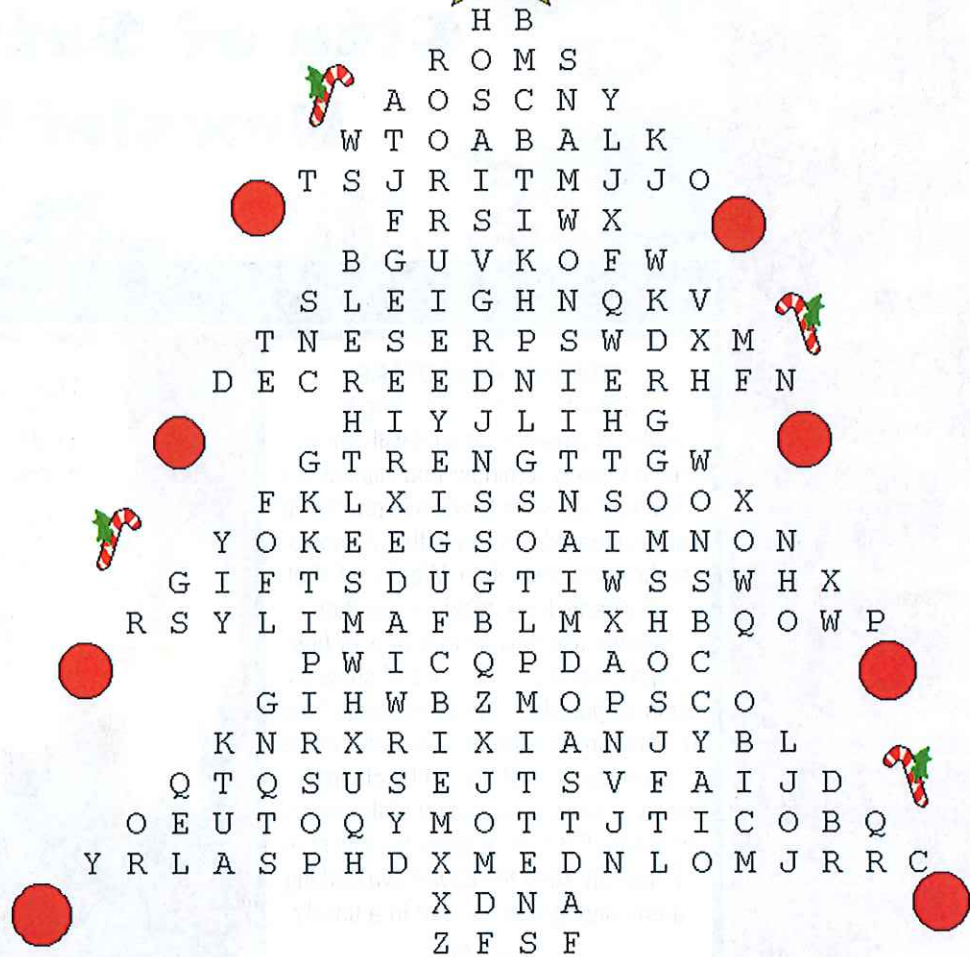
