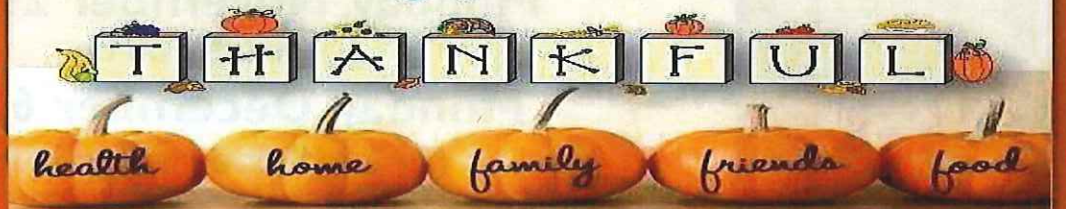

be on Wednesday November 24th.**

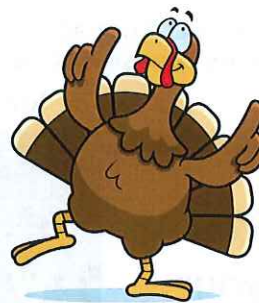
